- Agreement of Service for Municipal Solutions for Financial Services for the \$3million WIIA grant is in process.
- **Invoice from Shorewood** was received and shall be processed for payment
- Notification received from DASNY to execute the SAM grant disbursement agreement in the amount of \$100,000 to defray the cost of the 2,000 linear feet of 12 inch water main installed on Route 5 in the Town of Sheridan as part of the capital project. Chautauqua County Legislature to pass a resolution to accept the grant at their 12/18/19 Legislature meeting.
- Village of Brocton recently received an additional WIIA Grant –in the amount of \$1million to reduce the EFC loan of \$5,570,500. The new loan amount to be paid by the NCCWD per IMA contract 17-39-01 will be \$4,570,500 when the long term (30 year) financing has been closed.
- 2. Capital Project Construction Update Seth Krull
 - Update on progress of Contract 5 Meter Vaults. All five meter vaults will be installed and operational by the end of the year.

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- Discussion of Lateral Restriction required for Phase II in the area south of the Thruway in existing Ag. Districts to be processed as required by NYS Ag. & Markets and Chautauqua County Ag & Farmland Protection Board. A draft will be presented at the January NCCWD Board meeting and will be subject to confirmation by the Chautauqua County Legislature.
- Update was provided on Town of Dunkirk and Town of Portland projects Town of Dunkirk Roberts Road water main, Town of Portland design for Water District 2 improvements (Van Buren area).
- Route 5 N water main is completed, waiting for meter vaults to be on-line before abandoning Silver Creek service line. Hydrants will be required to be removed

Discussion:

- Athenex fire flow Jay Warren again expressed concerns for sufficient fire flow at new Athenex plant in Dunkirk. Current system is fed by 8" water main. When new 12" watermain comes on-line, it is expected that fire flow requirements will be met.
 - MOVED by Hazelton, SECONDED by Frost- a Motion in support of assisting the efforts of ATHENEX Engineers and Contractors, and the City of Dunkirk Water Department to ensure proper water flow volumes to the ATHENEX complex in the Town of Dunkirk, NY. Unanimously Carried
- Hazelton asked that a report of finances of CBI Water Works be provided at the next meeting of the NCCWD Board. Schrantz reported that efforts continue to isolate and document potential system water leaks to reduce water loss.
- Thanks and appreciation for outgoing member Board Chairman Supervisor Steger, Town of Pomfret.
