

1935 Revised Map of Fentonville Cemetery, incorporated 1904 at Fentonville, Town of Carroll, Chautauqua County, NY. Original map made by Harry Lee, Jamestown, NY, about 1917. Fentonville is in the SW corner of Carroll.

Frewsburg-Fentonville Road runs North – South. Map is drawn as if standing in Frewsburg-Fentonville Road and facing the cemetery with Lot 1 at the far right (i.e., South boundary), nearest the road. Lots are numbered in rows of 18 lots beginning at the Southern boundary of the Cemetery. The Old Section includes lots 1-197. This map was made to show the New Section, Lots 200-339, but no names are on those new lots.

In rows, with lot 1 in the SW corner and lot 18 in the SE corner, rows numbered right to left on the map. Most Lots are 10' x 20'

except Row 1, which is 10'x12'; Row 6, which is 10'x23'; Row 11, a row of half lots each 10'x9'; and Rows 12-15, which are 10'x21'
